## **Energy Bills**

There are a number of things you can do to effectively manage your energy bills and save money.

Turn off any Turn off electrical chargers once your appliance is fully charged, such as a laptop or mobile phone **Turning your** thermostat down by 1°C could save 10% on your heating bill but remember to LOW HIGH keep warm

Don't leave electrical items, like the TV and DVD player, on standby - switch them off at the sockets

Consider installing cavity wall and loft insulation and fitting draught-proofing to seal unwanted gaps around windows and doors

Replace your old lighting with more energy efficient options eq. LEDs

Have your boiler serviced annually

 'Be Warm' Oil Stamp Scheme: Belfast City Council's oil stamp saving scheme helps householders save for home heating oil. £5 stamps are available from a range of local outlets and are collected on a savings card. The stamps are accepted by a large number of oil distributors as full or part payment for a delivery of oil.

- Oil Clubs: Oil Buying Clubs help people to reduce the cost of a fill of oil by purchasing oil in bulk as part of a group. Belfast City Council together with the Public Health Agency has produced a booklet to support groups that want to establish an oil club in their area. Bryson Energy also facilitates a network of oil buying clubs across Northern Ireland.

- Pre-payment: A prepayment meter allows you to pay for gas and electricity as you use it. It can be a good way to budget and keep track of how much energy you are using. Some suppliers offer discounts for prepayment customers. If you want a prepayment meter, you should contact your supplier for more information.
